### Coming in March!

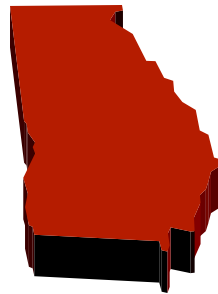

Our program is titled, **"You've Got The Time."** EVERYONE will receive their personal copy of the dramatic recording of the New Testament in MP3 format. You can listen 28 minutes for 40 days and "read" the entire disc. It is filled with music and dramatic presentation. We are getting the discs from a missions group, **"Faith Comes By Hearing."** Their goal is to get the New Testament to the 3 billion people who have never heard the gospel of Jesus Christ—in their own language. They are giving us the discs free, but we will be taking offerings to help prepare the gospel in another language. It cost \$964 to record one Bible book. That is the goal we are hoping to reach.
